12th Grade Meningococcal Vaccine

The Ohio Department of Health requires that all incoming 12th grade students receive two (2) doses of the meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine before school entrance.

If the first dose of the meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine was administered on or after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required. If the pupil is in the 12th grade and is 15 years of age or younger, only one (1) dose is required.

Ohio Physicians are aware of the vaccine requirements and are routinely administering the meningococcal vaccine during well child visits. All incoming 12th grade students will need to show proof of having received the meningococcal vaccine before they attend school in the fall. Complete documentation with the date and doctors office/healthcare provider information is required on the documentation.

Parents may fax or mail the immunization documentation to the address or fax below. Thank you for your cooperation in meeting this Ohio health requirement. Please feel free to call the school nurse at (330) 335-1403 for any questions you may have.

For students without a healthcare provider, the Medina County Health Department (MCHD) has an immunization clinic located at Summa Wadsworth-Rittman Hospital Founders Hall. The clinic is available on the 4th Wednesday of the month from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. Appointments are strongly recommended. Please call the Medina County Health Department at (330) 723-9688 or toll free 1-888-723-9688 for an appointment or vaccine information. There will also be a vaccination clinic at Wadsworth High School on August 16, 2017 at 9:30 am during schedule pick up. Parents must accompany their child to have proper paperwork filled out. Please take into consideration that the line for this immunization clinic can be long during schedule pick up.

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
