The City of Wadsworth, in partnership with Medina County and other Medina County communities, has implemented a state-of-the-art mass notification system to alert residents and businesses about emergencies, service interruptions and other important community events. The emergency notification system enables officials to provide essential information quickly when there is a threat to the health or safety of residents and businesses.

In addition to emergency information, you may:

- Select to receive messages regarding utility and public service notifications, community event information, public works projects, neighborhood crime alerts, and health department notifications.
- Choose the locations you want to be contacted about - your home, your parents' home, your workplace, and your child's school.
- Receive alerts on your home phone, cell phone, work phone, email, text messaging, facsimile or instant messaging.
