STUDENT DRIVING AND PARKING REGULATIONS / 2017-2018
PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION

Parking Permits will be issued to Juniors and Seniors on the dates listed below. You must purchase your own permit; no one else may purchase one for you and you MUST HAVE YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE WITH YOU!

Parking Permits will be sold to JUNIORS AND SENIORS ONLY on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, August 21, 22, and 23 between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. *This IS NOT on a first come – first serve basis.* If you are unable to purchase your Parking Permit on these days, you may purchase it BEFORE or AFTER school. DO NOT DRIVE until you have purchased your Parking Tag!

SOPHOMORES are not permitted to drive or purchase a Parking Tag until Mid-September.

REGISTRATION

Students **MUST** have the following items **WITH THEM** when they purchase a Parking Permit: **NO ONE MAY PURCHASE YOUR PASS FOR YOU!**

1. **Valid Ohio Driver's License.**
2. **Current Registration of each car you will be driving to school.**
3. **Completed Parking Permit Request Form signed by parent/guardian.**
4. **Signed Drug Testing Authorization Form.**

The cost of the Parking Permit is **\$25.00**. Lost or stolen Permits will be reissued at an additional cost of \$30.00 if approved by an administrator. Please address any further questions regarding driving to the high school, main office, 335-1400.

WADSWORTH HIGH SCHOOL – PARKING LOT RULES

1. Driving and parking at the high school is a privilege. Permits may be revoked if in violation of school rules.
2. All cars must be parked between marked yellow line areas. Parking is permitted **ONLY** in the Student Lot.
3. All students **MUST** have their Parking Permit clearly hung on their **REAR VIEW MIRROR.**
4. Any student with a parking privilege who becomes an attendance or discipline problem due to driving to school will have their parking privilege revoked.
5. Cars that are parked illegally or that do not have a Parking Permit displayed **will be towed.**
6. Any student who is caught buying, selling, or giving a Parking Permit to another student will **immediately** lose his/her parking privilege and receive disciplinary action.
7. Students are to drive carefully while on school grounds at all times. The speed limit is 5 MPH in the parking lot. Reckless driving on school property will result in the loss of parking privileges.
8. Upon arrival to school, students are to enter the building immediately. Students are not permitted to sit in their cars or loiter in the parking area. **NO SMOKING** in cars while on school property.
9. Students are responsible for their own car security. Keep vehicles locked. The school **is not responsible for theft or damage.** If a theft or damage occurs, notify the police, your insurance company, and the high school administration.
10. In order to purchase a parking permit, you are subject to our Random Drug Testing policy.
11. Students are not permitted to go to or move their cars during the school day without permission.
