



# Wadsworth City Schools Snow Days




During the winter months, inclement weather may necessitate the closing of school due to road conditions or problems with the heating or water systems in our buildings. Please understand that we make every effort to make this decision in the best interest of the students of this district. Generally, the decision to cancel is made by 6:00 a.m. and is sent by phone through our rapid notification system and posted on our web page, cable channel, and other media outlets shortly after. At times, the unpredictable Ohio weather can change rapidly and may not be exactly as forecasted. Even if weather conditions change, we cannot reverse our decision once it is made since parents make arrangements upon our early morning call. Nonetheless, we appreciate your patience and understanding as we evaluate the current conditions and assess the forecast in regards to closing school.



School district officials begin monitoring the weather and road conditions as early as 3:30 a.m. when inclement weather is predicted. Officials often consult the local road departments, law enforcement, the State Highway Patrol, school officials in neighboring districts, and the forecast. We take into consideration the impact a school closing has on families who need to arrange child care or provide an alternative to their children who are on the free and reduced breakfast or lunch program that would normally be served at school.



We remind parents and students that the best way to find out information about school closings is to update your phone number in our rapid notification system or turn to your local television or radio station for the latest report. Please do not call the main switchboard, individual school buildings, or the School Safety Hotline. We appreciate your cooperation in this area.



Again, we will make the best decision with the information we have on hand by 6:00 a.m. each day that inclement weather approaches. Thank you for your continued support.
