

Questions regarding attendance at a building other than your home base school:

- Q: My child is currently attending a school other than their home base school. May they continue attending school at their current building if it is not their assigned building after the reorganization?
or
- Q: My child will begin Kindergarten in 2011-2012 in a building other than their home base school assignment for 2012-2013. What do I do if I want my child to attend the building which will be assigned in 2012-2013 during the 2011-2012 school year?
or
- Q: If the new attendance boundaries have my child attending a new school other than my currently assigned home school, what are my options to stay in that school?
or
- Q: My child will be in fourth grade in 2012-2013, and based on the new attendance boundaries, would be assigned to a new building. Can my child remain in their current building?
- A: If you would like your child to attend a school other than your home school, you may petition for a transfer under *Open Enrollment*. Applications for the 2011-2012 will be available March 1, 2011 and will be accepted March 15 – March 31, 2011. Applications are available online (follow the link to *District Links and Forms*), from any of our school buildings, or the Administration Office. The deadline for submitting an application is March 31, 2011 at 4:00 PM. You will be notified, by letter, by June 1, 2011, whether your request has been granted or denied. Applications for the 2012-2013 school year will be available in March of 2012.

Prior to an open enrollment request, parents/guardians may want to consider that, for the most part, neighborhood children will be attending their home base school based on the current attendance boundaries.

Other Questions:

- Q: Will my child have an opportunity to visit the building before the start of school?
- A: Provided the new building is ready for occupancy, students will have an opportunity to visit during the new student orientation, which is held prior to the start of the school year.
- Q: What effect does redistricting have on transportation?
- A: Transportation will continue to be provided per the current district guidelines, including those students who are granted intra-district open enrollment.
- Q: Will the Bear Cub Program continue to be provided?
- A: Yes, the Bear Cub Program will continue. Information is available from our web site.




Attendance Zone Reorganization


Important information about reorganization of elementary attendance zones and plans for 2012 – 2013

We are providing this information based on the opening of three new elementary schools (Isham Elementary, Overlook Elementary, and Valley View Elementary) in 2012.



Isham Elementary




Valley View Elementary
